A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE SIX HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$630.00) TO THE LIVE OAK SOCIETY OF LSU TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF PURCHASING LIVE OAK TREES TO BE PLANTED AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS ON THE LSU CAMPUS.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE LIVE OAK SOCIETY OF LSU IS A SERVICE ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO THE BEAUTIFICATION OF CAMPUS AND PROVIDING SERVICE OPPORTUNNITIES TO LSU STUDENTS, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, IN ITS SHORT HISTORY THE LIVE OAK SOCIETY OF LSU HAS UNDERTAKEN MANY SERVICE PROJECTS TO BEAUTIFY THE CAMPUS, BOTH PLANTING TREES AND FLOWER BEDS, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE CAMPUS HAS AN AGING LIVE OAK POPULATION AND SEVERAL INSTANCES WHERE LIVE OAKS NEED TO BE REPLACED HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, REPLACING OLD LIVE OAKS WITH NEW LIVE OAKS IN A STRATEGIC WAY IS NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT THE LIVE OAK REMAINS THE CENTERPIECE AND PRIDE OF THE CAMPUS LANDSCAPE.

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE DOES HEREBY APPROPRIATE SIX HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$630.00) TO THE LIVE OAK SOCIETY OF LSU TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF PURCHASING LIVE OAK TREES.

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE.

PARAGRAPH 7: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT BACK TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 1999.
