49 LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE
50 PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON
51 THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
