**A RESOLUTION**

TO RECOMMEND TO GARY GRAHAM AND THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO MAKE THE UNIVERSITY MORE BIKER FRIENDLY AND CREATE BIKE LANES.

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, A SIGNIFICANT PORTION OF LSU STUDENTS CURRENTLY RIDE BIKES TO SCHOOL, AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, WITHOUT BIKE LANES THESE STUDENTS SHARE THE SIDEWALKS WITH PEDESTRIANS WHO ARE OFTEN RUN OVER BY BIKERS, AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, CREATING BIKE LANES WOULD MAKE THE CAMPUS A SAFER PLACE ON WHICH TO BOTH WALK AND RIDE BIKES, AND

**PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, CREATING BIKE LANES WOULD PROMOTE MORE STUDENTS TO RIDE BIKES TO CAMPUS, AND FURTHER CUT DOWN ON THE UNIVERSITY'S TRAFFIC AND PARKING PROBLEMS.

**PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE HEREBY RECOMMENDS TO GARY GRAHAM AND THE LSU DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO MAKE THE UNIVERSITY MORE BIKER FRIENDLY AND CREATE BIKE LANES.
