**TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$600.00) FROM THE LEGISLATIVE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND TRAVEL AND REGISTRATION FOR JOHN ‘JACK’ GREEN TO ATTEND THE 2018 ASSOCIATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF SUSTAINABILITY IN HIGHER EDUCATION (AASHE) CONFERENCE AND EXPO**

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE CONFERENCE WILL TAKE PLACE IN PITTSBURGH, PENNSYLVANIA FROM OCTOBER 2<sup>ND</sup> THROUGH 3<sup>RD</sup>; AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE AASHE CONFERENCE AND EXPO IS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR STUDENT LEADERS ACROSS THE UNITED STATES TO GATHER NEW AND INNOVATIVE IDEAS ON HOW TO ADVANCE CAMPUS SUSTAINABILITY AT THEIR HOME UNIVERSITIES; AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE FUNDING WILL GO TO THE FOLLOWING:  
**REGISTRATION: \$375.00**  
**AIRFARE: \$225.00**  
**TOTAL: \$600.00**

**PARAGRAPH 4:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT A MAXIMUM OF SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$600.00) FROM THE LEGISLATIVE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT BE USED TO FUND TRAVEL AND REGISTRATION FOR JOHN ‘JACK’ GREEN TO ATTEND THE 2018 ASSOCIATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF SUSTAINABILITY IN HIGHER EDUCATION (AASHE) CONFERENCE AND EXPO; AND

**PARAGRAPH 5:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS FINANCE BILL BE TRANSMITTED TO CORTNEY GREAVIS, STUDENT GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL COORDINATOR.

**PARAGRAPH 6:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
