**A BILL**

TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$495.00) FOR THE CREATION OF FIFTY (50) DOUBLE-SIDED SIGNS IN ORDER TO PROMOTE SPRING ELECTIONS.

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, SPRING ELECTIONS ARE SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 8 AND 15, 1998, AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, INCREASED PUBLICITY WILL BE NECESSARY IN ORDER TO MAKE THE AVERAGE STUDENT AWARE OF THE ELECTIONS, AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THESE SIGNS WILL BE USED TO PROMOTE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS FOR YEARS TO COME.

**PARAGRAPH 4:** THEREFORE, FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$495.00) IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED IN ORDER TO CREATE FIFTY (50) DOUBLE-SIDED SIGNS FOR SPRING ELECTIONS.

**PARAGRAPH 5:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE. ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT BACK TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 1998.
