**A FINANCE BILL**

**TO APPROPRIATE A MAXIMUM OF EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$18,000.00) FROM THE STUDENT SENATE INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO AID LSU FACILITY SERVICES IN FUNDING THE THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND DOLLAR (\$36,000) INSTALLATION OF LIGHTING ALONG THE WALKWAY BETWEEN THE PATRICK F. TAYLOR AND ENERGY, COAST & ENVIRONMENT PARKING LOTS LOCATED ON SOUTH QUAD DR.**

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE WILL ALLOCATE \$18,000.00 FROM THE INITIATIVES ACCOUNT IN ORDER TO FUND THE INSTALLATION OF LIGHTING ALONG THE WALKWAY BETWEEN THE PATRICK F. TAYLOR AND ENERGY, COAST & ENVIRONMENT PARKING LOTS LOCATED ON SOUTH QUAD DR.

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE WALKWAY CONNECTING THE PATRICK F. TAYLOR AND ENERGY, COAST & ENVIRONMENT PARKING LOTS ON SOUTH QUAD DRIVE LACK PROPER LIGHTING AND PRESENT A SAFETY HAZARD TO STUDENTS AND FACULTY WHO UTILIZE THE LOTS; AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, LSU FACILITY SERVICES HAS AGREED TO FUND THE REMAINING \$18,000.00 IN ORDER TO ENACT THIS LEGISLATION, TOTALING IN \$36,000.00; AND

**PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE INSTALLATION OF LIGHTING ALONG THIS WALKWAY WILL PROMOTE A SAFER ENVIRONMENT FOR STUDENTS AND FACULTY WHO UTILIZE THE PATRICK F. TAYLOR AND ENERGY, COAST & ENVIRONMENT PARKING LOTS.

**PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$18,000.00) WILL BE APPROPRIATED FROM THE INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO FUND THE INSTALLATION OF LIGHTING ALONG THE WALKWAY BETWEEN THE PATRICK F. TAYLOR AND ENERGY, COAST & ENVIRONMENT LOTS LOCATED ON SOUTH QUAD DR., AND

**PARAGRAPH 6:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE TRANSMITTED TO TAMMY MILLICAN, THE DIRECTOR OF FACILITY SERVICES AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY

**PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
