A RESOLUTION

TO OFFER CONDOLENCES TO THE CITY OF THOUSAND OAKS, CALIFORNIA, THE VENTURA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, PEPPERDINE UNIVERSITY, AND THE FAMILIES OF THOSE KILLED AT THE BORDERLINE BAR & GRILL ON NOVEMBER 7, 2018

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, ON THE NIGHT OF NOVEMBER 7, 2018, DOZENS OF STUDENTS AND PATRONS OF THE BORDERLINE BAR & GRILL IN THOUSAND OAKS, CALIFORNIA GATHERED TO CELEBRATE BIRTHDAYS, DRINK, AND DANCE; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, A LONE GUNMAN ENTERED THE BAR LATE THAT NIGHT AND KILLED ELEVEN PATRONS AND ONE VENTURA COUNTY SHERIFF'S SERGEANT IN A SENSELESS ACT OF UNEXPECTED VIOLENCE; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE PEACE OF ONE OF AMERICA'S SAFEST CITIES AND OF AN ESTABLISHMENT DEDICATED TO ENTERTAINMENT WAS SHATTERED IN AN TRAGEDY THAT SHOULD NEVER OCCUR NOR BE EXPECTED TO OCCUR IN OUR PROSPEROUS NATION; AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE STUDENTS OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY ENJOY THEMSELVES LIKE THOSE IN THOUSAND OAKS AND HOPE THAT A SIMILAR TRAGEDY NEVER BEFALLS THEM OR DISRUPTS THE FRAGILE PEACE OF OUR COMMUNITY; AND

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT THE STUDENTS OF THIS UNIVERSITY AND STUDENT SENATE OFFER OUR DEEPEST AND SINCEREST CONDOLENCES TO THE THOUSAND OAKS COMMUNITY, THE VENTURA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, PEPPERDINE UNIVERSITY, AND THE FAMILIES OF THE VICTIMS DURING THIS DIFFICULT TIME OF MOURNING, AND

PARAGRAPH 6: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS STUDENT GOVERNMENT COMMITS ITSELF TO ENSURING A SAFE AND PRODUCTIVE LEARNING AND SOCIAL ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL STUDENTS AT ALL TIMES, AND

PARAGRAPH 7: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS STUDENT GOVERNMENT COMMITS ITSELF TO STANDING AGAINST AND WORKING TO END ANY FURTHER VIOLENCE ACROSS

THE UNITED STATES AND WITHIN OUR OWN COMMUNITY,
AND

PARAGRAPH 8: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO DR. STACIA HAYNIE, INTERIM EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT AND PROVOST; STEWART LOCKETT, LSU STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT; AUSTIN WELCH, PEPPERDINE UNIVERSITY STUDENT GOVERNMENT PRESIDENT; GEOFF DEAN, VENTURA COUNTY SHERIFF; AND ANDREW FOX, MAYOR OF THOUSAND OAKS, CALIFORNIA

PARAGRAPH 9: THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (ONE-HALF PLUS ONE) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
