**A Finance Bill**

*To appropriate a maximum of three hundred and forty dollars and zero cents  
(\$340.00) from the Legislative Contingency account to purchase food and  
drink for the FLC portion of the Student Government Banquet.*

- 1 WHEREAS, the Student Government Banquet is scheduled for April 8,
- 2 2021, and only has the capacity for 125 attendees, thus cannot
- 3 accommodate about 40 attendees from Freshman Leadership Council;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, Freshman Leadership Council members have worked on
- 6 initiatives and learned about Student Government from the
- 7 perspective of all three branches over the past Fall and Spring
- 8 semesters; and
- 9 WHEREAS, there will not be enough space to accommodate
- 10 approximately 40 FLC members and directors at the SG banquet, they
- 11 will instead be hosting a banquet and livestreaming the large SG
- 12 banquet on LSU’s campus; and



13 WHEREAS, the members of the Freshman Leadership Council should  
14 be celebrated along with the members of Student Government  
15 celebrating the end of the school year; and

27 Student Government banquet; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE  
29 TRANSMITTED TO Taylor Halsey, Director of Freshman Leadership  
30 Council, Angelina Cantelli, Deputy Chief of Staff, and Courtney  
31 Greavis, Student Government Financial Coordinator

32 THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-  
33 THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND  
34 SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR  
35 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT  
36 AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE  
37 DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
