A Bill

*To amend the Student Government Code to revise Section 208:
Removal generally; graduate student exceptions*

Enacted,

1 Amend:

2 § 208. Removal generally; graduate student exceptions

3 A Senator shall be removed from their position by the Speaker once
4 they have accumulated: (1) a total of three unexcused absences from
5 Regular Session meetings per Regular Session, or (2) a total of three
6 unexcused absences from meetings of their assigned committee per
7 Regular Session. These requirements do not apply to Senators
8 representing the Graduate School, the School of Veterinary Medicine, or
9 the Paul M. Hebert Law Center. Each Senator representing these
10 Academic Areas must meet with the Speaker at the beginning of each
11 Regular Session to determine appropriate requirements based on their
12 academic demand.

14 § 208. Removal generally; graduate student exceptions


15 A Senator shall be removed from their position by the Speaker once
16 they have accumulated: a total of three (3) unexcused absences from
17 either Regular Session or their assigned committee. These requirements
18 do not apply to Senators representing the Graduate School, the School
19 of Veterinary Medicine, or the Paul M. Hebert Law Center. Each

20 Senator representing these Academic Areas must meet with the Speaker
21 at the beginning of each Regular Session to determine appropriate
22 requirements based on their academic demand. Failure to meet with the
23 Speaker by the beginning of the third general meeting will result in
24 Graduate, Vet, or Law senators abiding by normal removal terms laid
25 out above, meaning after three (3) unexcused absences, they will be
26 removed.

28 THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-
29 THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND
30 SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR
31 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND
32 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF
33 SUCH APPROVAL.
