A Bill

- 1 *To appropriate a maximum of \$8,500 from the initiatives account for*
- 2 *the purchase and installation of 6 hammock stand poles*
- 3 WHEREAS, many students enjoy hammocking on campus; and
- 4 WHEREAS, hanging hammocks from trees over long periods of time
- 5 can cause extensive damage to the trees; and
- 6 WHEREAS, having these hammock stands will give students more
- 7 places on campus to relax in their hammocks; and
- 8 WHEREAS the funds will be allocated as follows:
- 9 1. A maximum of \$8,500 for the purchase of materials and
- 10 installation of hammock stands
- 11 a. These stands will be installed in the following locations
- 12 i. In front of PFT
- 13 ii. The enchanted forest

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED THAT a maximum of \$8,500 from the Initiatives account be allocated to facility services for the purchase and installation of 6 hammock stand poles

14 BE IT FURTHER ENACTED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE
15 SUBMITTED TO Cortney Greavis, Student Government Program Manager
16 and Dennis Mitchell, Assistant Director of Physical Plant/Facility Services

17 THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-
18 THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND
19 SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR

20 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND
21 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF
22 SUCH APPROVAL.
