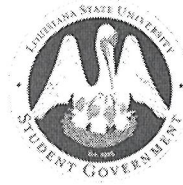

A Concurrent Resolution

To appoint Matthew McClure as a legislative delegate for the LGBTQ+ Caucus

- 1 WHEREAS, Legislative Branch member, Matthew McClure, is a
- 2 student leader that represents the students on campus through their
- 3 position on the Legislative Branch; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the aforementioned name was appointed by the Student Body
- 5 Speaker; and
- 6 WHEREAS, it is the Senate's duty to confirm these appointments; and
- 7 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE
- 8 UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE, that Student Government appoint
- 9 Matthew McClure as a legislative delegate for the SG LGBTQ+ Caucus
- 10 THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE by a simple
- 11 majority (one-half plus one) vote of the LSU Student Senate and signature by
- 12 the Student Body President, upon lapse of time for presidential action, or if
- 13 vetoed by the President and subsequently approved by the Senate, on the
- 14 date of such approval.
