A Resolution

To Urge and Request Student Health Center to recruit a higher number of diverse Mental Health professionals

1 WHEREAS, Louisiana State University’s Mental Health Services has 6
2 vacancies since Fall 2021.

3 WHEREAS, students at Louisiana State University need timely mental
4 health appointments, which becomes difficult for the LSU Mental
5 Health Services to provide considering the shortage of staff.

6 WHEREAS, LSU Mental Health Services also need to recruit health
7 providers who are from diverse backgrounds to understand students
8 coming from different backgrounds.

9 WHEREAS, my meeting with Director of Mental Health Ms. Raimé
10 Thibodeaux, MA, LPC-S, NCC reiterates the need to have a higher
11 number of diverse mental health professionals for LSU Students
12 immediately.

13 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE
14 UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE, that Student Government urges and
15 requests LSU Student Health Center to fill vacancies and recruit a
16 higher number of diverse mental health professionals for LSU students.


23 THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE by a
