A Resolution

To Urge and Request LSU Parking and Transportation to adopt the policy that the LSU Community may have their first parking violation voided from record, excluding fines for parking in ADA spaces and other specified violations, and making this policy known to the LSU community by including it on the P&T website and Rules and Regulations.

1 WHEREAS, LSU Parking and Transportation is the sole issuer of
2 parking violations on LSU's flagship Baton Rouge campus
3 ; and

5 WHEREAS, LSU Parking and Transportation informally grants
6 students a one-time void after their first parking violation if they
7 contact the Parking and Transportation office
8 ; and

10 WHEREAS, This should become a formal LSU P&T policy and be
11 common knowledge amongst the LSU community; and

13 WHEREAS, there is no mention of this one-time void in the Rules and
14 Regulations on the LSU Parking and Transportation website
15 ; and

16 WHEREAS, we also urge and request that this void would not be
17 applicable to any fine for parking, stopping, or standing in an ADA

18 (accessible parking) space without a handicap/disabled person license
19 plate; parking at an ADA (accessible) ramp or at a curb cut,

21 WHEREAS, this void would also not be eligible for any fines for parking
22 in places not designated for parking including fire lanes, red zones, or
23 any "No Parking" areas.

25 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE
26 UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE, that Student Government urges
27 LSU Parking and Transportation to adopt a formal policy, that is
28 currently in practice, of voiding one's first Parking violation from
29 record, excluding the fines designated above, and adding the
30 aforementioned information to the department's website and Rules and
31 Regulations.

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION
34 BE SUBMITTED TO Brian Favela, Director, LSU Parking and
35 Transportation, and Damien Ruben, Assistant Director Public Relations
36 and Parking, LSU Parking and Transportation.

38 THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE by a
39 simple majority (one-half plus one) vote of the LSU Student Senate and
40 signature by the Student Body President, upon lapse of time for
41 presidential action, or if vetoed by the President and subsequently
42 approved by the Senate, on the date of such approval.
