A Resolution

To Urge and Request Parking & Transportation Services to install three electric vehicle chargers in locations that are accessible to students and are compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

4 WHEREAS, Parking & Transportation Services has already
5 created plans to purchase electric vehicle charging stations
6 and expand electric vehicle parking on campus; and
7

8 WHEREAS, the planned electric vehicle parking expansion
9 aligns with the current Louisiana State University Master
10 Plan that is focused on increasing and improving
11 environmental sustainability measures at LOUISIANA
12 STATE UNIVERSITY; and
13

14 WHEREAS, all actionable environmental sustainability
15 measures demonstrate that Louisiana State University is
16 committed to environmental sustainability; and
17

18 WHEREAS, all actionable environmental sustainability
19 measures have rippling effects that will benefit all members
20 of the Louisiana State University community, the greater
21 Baton Rouge community, and all residents of the State of
22 Louisiana; and

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24 WHEREAS, sustainability measures both attract prospective
25 students to Louisiana State University and retain currently
26 enrolled students, all of whom contribute to the financial
27 sustainability of Louisiana State University; and

29 WHEREAS, the majority of the planned locations for electric
30 vehicle charging stations will be inside the gates of the
31 campus that are closed to students Monday through Friday
32 between the hours of 7:00am to 4:30pm; and

33
34 WHEREAS, none of the current electric vehicle charging
35 stations are in parking spaces that are compliant with the
36 Americans with Disabilities Act.

38 WHEREAS, three electric vehicle charging stations that are
39 part of the planned electric vehicle parking expansion are not
40 yet assigned to specific locations; and

41
42 WHEREAS, electric vehicle charging stations installed in
43 Touchdown Village West Lot X174 (near the intersection of
44 Engineering Lane & S. Quad Drive), any of the All Zone (X
45 Zone) parking lots by the UREC, and the Parker Coliseum
46 Lot would best serve Louisiana State University
47 students; and

49 WHEREAS, if any of the proposed locations for electric
50 vehicle charging stations are deemed infeasible with
51 sufficient reason, the Louisiana State University Student
52 Senate still urges and requests that Parking & Transportation
53 Services install the three electric vehicle charging stations
54 without a location assignment in locations where they will be
55 accessible to Louisiana State University students Monday
56 through Friday between the hours of 7:00am to 4:30pm and
57 in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act; and

59 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
60 STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE, that Student
61 Government urges and requests that Parking &
62 Transportation Services install the three electric vehicle
63 charging stations without a location assignment in locations
64 that are both accessible to students Monday through Friday
65 between the hours of 7:00am to 4:30pm and compliant with
66 the Americans with Disabilities Act.

70 of Parking & Transportation Services; Tammy Millican


