*To allocate \$1,500 from the Student Government
Contingency Account to fund the renovation and
optimization of the Mechanical Engineering Graduate
repository*

- 1 WHEREAS, the current MEGSA website does not have the
2 desired functionality and can be found at this link:
3 <https://lsudmegsa.wixsite.com/megsa>; and
4 WHEREAS, MEGSA considered doing the improvements
5 themselves. However, they determined that doing it
6 themselves would be exceptionally time consuming and they
7 could not achieve the level of functionality, detail, and
8 professionalism possible through hiring someone; and
9 WHEREAS, some of the desired functionality of the website
10 MEGSA has found is highly desired by students include a
11 message board, updated events calendar, a portal for
12 submitting anonymous statements, a resource repository for
13 helpful links, and critical documents; and
14 WHEREAS, MEGSA has considered already investigated
15 using the current LSU run webpage, but the quality of the
16 message board and anonymous submission portal would not
17 be possible and/or of much lower quality on something like
18 the LSU department website.

19 WHEREAS, the \$1,500 would be enough money for about 1-
20 2 weeks of work from a professional designer; and

21 WHEREAS, the plan is to have the graduate school cover
22 yearly the cost of using the domain name; and

23 WHEREAS, Student Government will be recognized by
24 having the Student Government Logo on the website and
25 through having the MCHE Dean recognize the student
26 government funding at future events.

27 WHEREAS, the expense breakdown for this allocation is as
28 follows:



32 Website update.


33 THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A
