A Bill

A bill to appropriate \$15,500 from the Student Government Initiatives Account to fund the purchase of six (6) Bicycle Repair "Fixit" stations

1 WHEREAS, THE ONLY RESOURCE FOR STUDENTS TO FIX THEIR
2 BIKES AROUND CAMPUS "CAPITAL CYCLERY" RECENTLY CLOSED;
3 AND

4 WHEREAS, THERE IS CURRENTLY ONE (1) "FIXIT" STATION BY
5 THE UNIVERSITY RECREATION (UREC) FACILITY THAT WAS
6 INSTALLED IN 2020 AND IS REMAINS A FULLY FUNCTIONAL
7 RESOURCE TO STUDENTS TO FIX COMMON BIKE ISSUES INCLUDING
8 FLAT TIRES AND LOOSENED SEATS; AND

9 WHEREAS, A 2016 MASTER PLAN SURVEY FOUND THAT
10 APPROXIMATELY 14% OF STUDENTS TRAVEL AROUND CAMPUS BY
11 BIKE, NOTING A "SIGNIFICANT POTENTIAL FOR A MORE ROBUST
12 NETWORK OF BICYCLE PATHS, ON-CAMPUS AMENITIES SUCH AS
13 LOCKERS AND SHOWERS, **REPAIR STATIONS** AND SECURE,
14 WEATHER PROTECTED BIKE PARKING; AND

15 WHEREAS, AFTER COMMUNICATIONS WITH JOSH GALASSO,
16 PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES SHOULD BE ABLE TO
17 COVER THE COST OF INSTALLING THE "FIXIT" STATIONS; AND

18 WHEREAS, ONCE INSTALLED, THE LSU BIKING MAP WILL BE
19 UPDATED TO SHOW THE REPAIR STATION'S LOCATIONS. IDEALLY,

20 THE LSU MOBILE APP WILL ALSO BE UPDATED SO STUDENTS CAN
21 USE THE CAMPUS MAP TO SEE THE REPAIR STATION LOCATIONS.

22 WHEREAS, ONE "FIXIT" REPAIR STATIONS WOULD BE PLACED IN
23 EACH OF THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS: BY THE LAVILLE RACKS
24 (REPLACE CURRENT BROKEN PUMP), BY THE PFT/BEC RACKS, BY
25 THE STUDENT UNION RACKS, BY THE LSU LIBRARY (REPLACE
26 CURRENT BROKEN PUMP), BY THE NICHOLSON RACKS, AND BY THE
27 SPRUCE/CYPRESS RACKS.

28 WHEREAS, THE EXPENSE BREAKDOWN FOR THIS INITIATIVE IS AS
29 FOLLOWS:

30 "FIXIT" PUMP: AIR KIT 4: \$2,159.00 x 6= \$12,954.00

31 SHIPPING: \$647.70*

32 TAXES: \$1,554.48*





35 THEREFOR BE IT ENACTED THAT \$15,500 IS ALLOCATED
36 FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO
37 FUND THE PURCHASE OF FIVE (5) BICYCLE REPAIR "FIXIT"
38 STATIONS

39 THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A
40 TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE
41 AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF
42 TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY
43 THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY
44 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
