**Concurrent Resolution**

*To PLACE A REFERENDUM BEFORE THE  
LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT BODY IN  
THE FALL 2022 ELECTION TO AMEND THE SELF-  
ASSESSED STUDENT GOVERNMENT FEE TO \$3.50 PER  
FULL TIME STUDENT*

- 2 WHEREAS, all Full-Time students currently pay the Student  
3 Government fee; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Part-Time and Online students do not pay the  
5 Student Government fee due to the lack of services they  
6 receive from the institution; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Student Government can more effectively serve  
8 students in classes and on campus through a variety of  
9 events and resources directed to these students; and
- 10 WHEREAS, students should be given the opportunity to vote  
11 on the self-assessed Student Government fee through a  
12 ballot referendum; and
- 13 WHEREAS, an ever-expanding tuition and fee bill  
14 continuously gives more money to a bloated administration  
15 taking power and influence away from the Students; and
- 16 WHEREAS, students need to reinvest in their representative  
17 organization to enable Student Government to effectively  
18 advocate and organize programs; and

19 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA  
20 STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE, that a  
21 referendum is placed before the Louisiana State University  
22 student body in the Fall 2022 election to amend the self-  
23 assessed Student Government fee to \$3.50 per full time  
24 student

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS  
26 RESOLUTION BE SUBMITTED TO the Louisiana State  
27 University Student Government Election Commission.

28 THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON  
29 PASSAGE by a two-thirds vote of the LSU Student Senate  
30 and signature by the Student Body President, upon lapse of  
31 time for presidential action, or if vetoed by the President and  
32 subsequently approved by the Senate, on the date of such  
33 approval.
