*To appropriate \$1080.72 from the Student
Government initiatives account for the college of science
residential life Pre-Health students to attend the Our Lady
of the Lake Open House*

Enacted,

1 WHEREAS, The college of science residential life began
2 piloting a program where students may attend the Our Lady
3 of the Lake Open House. to provide first year pre-health
4 students an opportunity to experience a hospital setting
5 firsthand as well as network with healthcare professionals ;
6 and

7 WHEREAS of the students who attended last year 30% of the
8 students were first generation and 37% are underrepresented
9 students ; and

10 WHEREAS, this event would be the first opportunity that
11 many of these students would have to experience anything in
12 the healthcare field ; and

13 WHEREAS, this opportunity has shown to offer networking
14 potential as well as shadowing opportunities for students
15 who have never been given the opportunity ; and

16 WHEREAS, the pilot last year showed major success so a
17 motion to increase the amount of students able to attend was
18 requested ; and

19 WHEREAS, the application for funding from ORF was
20 declined due to the Residential Life for Pre-Health Students
21 not being a registered student organization ; and

22 Whereas, The Funding for this event is lined as
23 \$1645.00 for the transportation of all attending
24 \$457.72 to feed all involved including, students, faculty, staff,
25 and 15 (LOLO) VIP's.


26 \$1022.00 has been paid for by sponsors
27 The total amount needed would be \$1,080.72

30 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY
31 AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT THE
32 LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT AND SENATE APPROPRIATE
33 \$1,080.72 FROM THE INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO HELP FUND THE
34 COLLEGE OF SCIENCE RESIDENTIAL LIFE PRE-HEALTH STUDENTS
35 TRIP TO THE OUR LADY OF THE LAKE OPEN HOUSE

36 THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A
37 TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE
38 AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF
39 TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY
40 THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY
41 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
